ADMISSION TEST FOR PhD PROGRAMME - FEBRUARY 2010

Instructions to candidates

1. Candidates will not be allowed to appear for the Written Test without the duly filled **ADMIT CARD** sent along with the call letter or down loaded from the website.
2. Candidates should report at the venue of the written test by 8:00 hrs on the day of their examination. The Written Test is from 9.00hrs to 11.00hrs. Candidates arriving later than 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination will not be permitted to take the test.
3. Candidates will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall only after 60 minutes of the commencement of the test.
4. Candidates should come prepared to stay for two days in Trivandrum. Candidates short listed based on the Written Test will be called for interview on the following day. Kindly note that IIST will not provide any accommodation.
5. Outstation candidates will be paid to and fro sleeper class train fare by shortest route or actual fare (whichever is lower) for attending the test. Candidates are requested to produce original/copy of the tickets. Payment will be made at the venue of the Written Test after the test.
6. *The list of candidates eligible to appear for the interview based on performance in the written examination will be displayed on the institute website (www.iist.ac.in) at 21:00 hrs on the day of the written test. The same will be available in IIST notice board at ATF campus (VSSC), Veli, Thiruvananthapuram.*
7. Candidates selected for interview are required to produce the ADMIT CARD, original and attested true copies of all the certificates, mark lists and testimonials of their qualifications, experience, age etc., at the time of the interview, without which they will not be allowed to attend the interview.
8. The Candidates may use scientific but programmable/graphic calculators.
9. Malpractices in any form or any misconduct will disqualify his/her candidature for the admission.

General Information

1. There are frequent bus services from the Central Bus Station opposite to the Central Railway Station, Thiruvananthapuram (Trivandrum) to **Mar Ivanios College (MIC)**. The college is approximately 10 km from central railway station (Auto fare is roughly Rs. 60). The venue is approximately 14 km from Trivandrum Airport.
2. Budget accommodation is easy to find around the Trivandrum Central Railway Station.
3. Interviews will be held at **Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology (IIST)**. The campus is adjacent to Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) located on the Veli Hills which is 12km from Trivandrum Central Railway Station and 7km from Trivandrum Airport.
